What is TAG?

TAG = Teen Advisory Group

TAG is a volunteer opportunity for teens!

Members of the Teen Advisory Group will receive volunteer hour credits for attending TAG meetings and for participating in any TAG projects!

TAG membership requires a commitment for the school year, and meetings are usually held monthly, alternating planning meetings with fun projects. Each TAG chooses new projects annually, with the guidance of the TAG coordinator.



As a TAG member, you will:

- gain leadership and teamwork skills
- make a difference in library services for teens at the public library
- make new friends



What do TAG members do?

That's up to you! But some ideas are:

- Recommend books, magazines, CDs, DVDs and other materials for the library to purchase.
- Write reviews of books, CDs and DVDs for the library's teen website.
- Suggest ideas for programs for teens, and assist with organizing and promoting teen programs.
- Participate in community events, such as the Santa Claus Parade.

Who can join the TAG?

You can, if you are between 12 and 18 years old and have a Kingston Frontenac Public Library card!

The TAG at each branch is limited to 21 members. The library will make an effort to form a group that represents the community the branch serves and includes teens of all ages.

To join, complete the attached membership form. If there is an open space in the TAG, we'll call you to set up a quick interview. Once accepted, you will need to provide a criminal record check, but we will refund the cost after you've attended three meetings.
