What is TRB?

TRB equals Teen Review Board

The TRB are teens who:

Love to read.

Watch lots of movies.

Spend hours playing video games.

Listen to music by a wide range of artists.

Like to share their opinion.

TRB members review books, audiobooks, movies, games and music borrowed from the library. High school students receive one volunteer hour credit for each submitted review that meets our guidelines.

Basically, you earn volunteer hours by doing what you already love – you just have to tell us about it!

Reviews submitted by the TRB will be posted on the library's website and used in a myriad of ways to promote the library's collections.

TRB reviewing is done on your own time. There are no meetings, and no scheduled hours. If you have internet access, you can submit reviews online any time. If not, you can drop them off at your neighbourhood branch whenever you visit.

Basic TRB Review Guidelines

Full guidelines will be provided to TRB members.

All items reviewed must be in the Kingston Frontenac Public Library's collection.

Single word or one line reviews won't be accepted. We're looking for thoughtful reviews that share your opinion.

This might seem obvious, but you must write the review yourself!

Our rating system

One star – Do yourself a favour. Don't bother!

Two stars – Easy to put down.
Three stars – Worth your time.
Four stars – In this year’s top ten.
Five stars – Stayed up all night!
