### **Opportunity**

KFPL's French Reading Buddies program nurtures the developing literacy skills of young readers. Teen volunteers and Library staff collaborate to provide French reading support and fun literacy activities for developing readers who are ages 6 to 9.

#### **Role and Responsibilities**

As a volunteer, you will attend training sessions to learn about working with younger readers, and your responsibilities as a KFPL volunteer.

- Assist with the delivery of French Reading Buddies content
- Create a positive, fun and enriching environment for younger readers
- Support young readers as they develop French literacy skills
