KFPL's French Reading Buddies program nurtures the developing literacy skills of young readers. Teen volunteers and Library staff collaborate to provide French reading support and fun literacy activities for developing readers who are in Grades 1 through 3. The upcoming session will be offered virtually through Zoom.

Role and Responsibilities

Volunteers must have access to a computer with stable Internet access, a webcam and a microphone in order to participate on Zoom.

As a volunteer, you will attend training sessions to learn about working with younger readers, the technical requirements of virtual programming, and your responsibilities as a KFPL volunteer.

- Commit to all program dates
- Assist with the delivery of virtual French Reading Buddies content
- Create a positive, fun and enriching environment for younger readers
- Support young readers as they develop French literacy skills
