Want to join a book club but don't want to follow a strict reading schedule? KFPL has a program for you! Join our monthly Book Chat, an online, casual, book-discussion mixer for adults and new adults who like to read. Seniors are welcome, too.

"If you like to talk about what you've been reading but don't want to read an assigned title, check out KFPL's online Book Chat," said Anne Hall, Programming and Outreach Librarian.

Every month, KFPL staff and Book Chat participants meet virtually to discuss books and other media in relation to a theme. The October theme will be "Books and Libraries," the November theme will be "Found Families," and the December theme will be "Holidays."

Participants are encouraged to have a book to talk about briefly, or to prepare open-ended questions related to the theme. Of course, everyone can feel free to chat about any book-related topic that excites them.

Book Chat takes place on the third Wednesday of each month, from 6 to 7:30 p.m. via Zoom. Participants will receive their Zoom link upon registration and will require the latest version of the software on their device.
