Do you have questions about the Kingston Frontenac Public Library's proposed Extended Hours Project? Join us for a conversation at an upcoming open house!

KFPL is considering the use of technology to extend access to our Pittsburgh Branch in Kingston's East end. Extended hours would supplement our existing hours of operation to provide access to space and resources that would otherwise be inaccessible for many hours a week. "Kingston East continues to grow and an expansion of library services at has been in our plans since 2004," Sutherland Mills shared. "We're looking for innovative ways to extend our services within budget constraints. This project would increase access to the branch and its resources by 22 hours per week, bringing hours of operation from 38 to 60 hours each week."
