Kingscourt Branch closes; pop-up library service begins

Big changes to library service in the north end of Kingston are under way.

Saturday, September 16, is the final day of service for the Kingscourt branch on Kirkpatrick Street. The last day at this branch will be marked by celebrations and fond farewells. A very special children's concert will be given by award-winning performer Peter Puffin, and light refreshments will be served. The celebrations go from 2 to 5 p.m., and the children's show will be at 3 p.m. Come join in the fun!

There will still be library service in Kingston's north end when Kingscourt closes, though. On Monday, September 18, we will introduce our brand-new pop-up library! This mobile library will circulate in a library vehicle throughout the community to provide services until the new Rideau Heights branch opens in the Rideau Heights Community Centre in early 2018. The pop-up library will offer such services as reservations pick-up and Internet access. There will be a small browsing collection of books and DVDs, and patrons will be able to borrow and return materials. Look for our branded mini-van and friendly staff at the following locations:
